GUADO AL MELO – TREASURES FROM BOLGHERI

The Bolgheri district along Tuscan's west coast in the Upper Maremma has become one of the most prized wine zones in all of Tuscany. Ever since the Tenuta San Guido estate began producing wines primarily from Cabernet Sauvignon in the 1960s, this area has been a destination for vintners looking to expand Tuscan viticulture.

One of the most interesting estates located here is **GUADO AL MELO**, owned by Michele Scienza. Scienza founded the estate in 2000 and today produces 6500 cases of several types of wines per year, including an IGT white as well as Bolgheri Rosso and Bolgheri Rosso Superiore. The most unique wine made here is undoubtedly **Jassarte**, a blend of 30 different varieties!
